

Hillcrest Unacceptable Items:

Donations must not be contaminated, all items must be re-sellable and all donations items are at the discretion of Hillcrest's donation policies and guidelines or storage space.

Furniture:

- Damaged furniture: soiled, torn, with odor, broken, pet hair, in need of repair
- Beds: mattresses, box springs, coil springs, waterbeds, hide-beds, bunk beds, futon beds
- Office furniture (other than home office furniture) and cubicles
- Bean bag chairs
- Chests/Trunks: with automatic locks or latches that can be engaged and thus prevent escape
- Large entertainment centers and China cabinets

Electronics:

- Televisions: tube televisions and console televisions
- Handheld hair dryers without immersion protection
- Halogen lamps, fluorescent bulb, fluorescent fixture
- Items with damaged electrical cords

Children's

- Car seats, strollers, cribs, baby beds, play pens/play yards, baby bath seats, walkers and any other product that holds a child
- Toys with lead-based paint, magnets, and phthalates.
- Toy chests
- Helmets (used of any kind)
- Breast pumps, baby bottles and baby nipples

Misc:

- Pianos or organs
- Built-in appliances & fixtures (hardwired): dishwashers, furnaces, microwaves, ceiling fans, lighting fixtures, garage door, vinyl siding, shower doors, water heaters
- Construction materials: lumber, pipes, floors, tubs, cabinets, carpet, doors, windows, etc.
- Automobile parts: tires, mufflers, fenders, batteries, etc
- Weapons: firearms and imitation guns, explosives, ammunition, flares,
- Flammable products: any items that contain or operate on fuel, gas cans, propane cylinders, tiki torches, etc.
- Hazardous materials: batteries, paints, paint cans, chemicals, cleaning products, poisons
- Life jackets - adults and children
- Any type of pornographic material
- Drug paraphernalia
- Yard waste
